Latticed Flower Scarf

Yarn:

2 balls ZARA (MC for Lattice)

2 part balls ZARA (C1 & C2 for flowers)

Hook: 4.50 mm



Using MC, make 38 chains.

1st row: 1 tr into 8th ch from hook, 2 ch, miss 2 ch, 1 tr into next ch, rep from* to end finishing with 1 tr in last chain.

2nd row: (1 dc 1 ch) into 1st tr, *2ch, miss 2 ch, 1 tr on top of next tr, rep from * to turning chains at end of row. 1 tr into 3rd turning chain (space should be the same as across the row)

Repeat the 2nd row until work measures approx 150cm. Finish off and sew in ends.

Large Flowers: Make 6 in both C1 and C2 and 4 in MC.

Using 4.50 crochet hook make 4 ch and join with sl st to form ring.

1st round: 1 ch, 12 dc into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first ch.

2nd round: 4 ch, 3 dtr into 1st dc, 4 ch, 1 dc into same dc. *Miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, 3 dtr into same dc, 4 ch, 1 dc into same dc. Rep from * until 6 petals have been worked.

Finish off and sew in ends.

Small Flowers: Make 4 in both C1 and C2

Using 4.50 mm hook, make 4 ch and join with a sl st to form ring.

1st round: 1 ch, 12 dc into the ring and join with sl st to form ring.

2nd round: 3 ch, 3 tr into 1st dc, 3 ch, 1 dc into same dc. *Miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 ch, 3 tr into same dc, 3 ch, 1 dc into same dc. Rep from * until 6 petals have been worked.

Finish off and sew in ends.

Make Up:

Places flowers randomly at both ends of scarf and secure in place.

Tassels: Make 4

Using double thickness of MC, make length of chain 28 cm long. Attach one length through each corner and knot ends.
