

Wondoflex Yarn Craft Centre

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Corkscrew Knitted Scarf

Yarn: 1 X 100gm hank 12ply
TOUCH or SOFTSPUN mohair
or
2 balls PICASSO 12 ply mohair
or
3 balls VERO, JOY or JET 12 ply

Needles: 1 pair 7.50 mm

Abbreviations:

wt (wrap and turn): Slip next st to right needle as if to purl, bring yarn to front between the needles (do not bring yarn over needle). This is referred to as the Wrap. Return slipped st to left needle, bring yarn to back between the needles. The stitch is now Wrapped. Turn work.



Kwtog (knit Wrap and Wrapped Stitch together): Insert tip of right needle under the wrap as if to knit, then into the wrapped stitch, and knit both loops together (the wrap and the stitch).

Scarf

Cast on 22 sts.

Next row: sl 1, k10, p11.

The next 7 rows form the pattern:

Row 1: sl 1, k8, wt,

Row 2: purl to end.

Row 3: sl 1, k6, wt,

Row 4: purl to end

Row 5: sl 1, k4, wt,

Row 6: purl to end

Row 7: sl 1, k4, [kwtog, k1] 3 times, purl to end.

Repeat rows 1-7 until all yarn is used. Cast off and sew in ends.
